The Position:

Study director for pre-clinical safety studies in rodents and non rodents. Other responsibilities will be the management of a group of animal lab technicians and animal keepers, resolution of issues, timely communication of all critical data to project toxicologist or area expert, manage organizational study aspects in close interaction with involved colleagues and line manager, tracking of timelines.
